G/TBT/N/CHN/140	28/09/05	China - Electronic products In order to control and reduce environmental pollution caused by discarded waste electronic information products, save resources and promote sustainable development of the electronic information industry, the Administration on the Control of Pollution Caused by Electronic Information Products (hereinafter referred to as the "Administration") is hereby promulgated in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Law of the People's Republic of China on Promotion of Clean Production, the Law of the People's Republic of China on the Prevention and Control of Environmental Pollution by Solid Waste, the Law of the People's Republic of China on Products Quality and other laws and regulations. The Administration totally has 4 Chapters with 27 Articles. According to the provision of the Administration, the electronic information products sold in the market within the territory of China shall satisfy with the following requirements: the environmental protection materials, technologies and processes shall be introduced according to the National Standards or sectoral standards; the safe-use life, names and contents of toxic and harmful substances contained therein and recovery marks shall be clearly indicated on the products; non-toxic, harmless, readily degradable and recyclable materials shall be used as the packaging materials, and the materials ingredients of the packaging shall be clearly marked. The method of Catalogue shall be adopted for the restriction and prohibition of the use of toxic and harmful substances in electronic information products. From the date of enforcement of this document, the electronic information products listed in the Catalogue for Pollution Control in Key Electronic Information Products shall not contain lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and other toxic and harmful substances. For those products which toxic and harmful substances cannot be completely replaced, the contents of such toxic and harmful substances shall not exceed the limit provided by relevant national or sectoral standards on electronic information products pollution control. This Catalogue will be adjusted annually according to the actual conditions and with the development of science and technology. The Ministry of Information Industry, the National Development and Reform Commission, the Ministry of Commerce, the General Administration of Customs, the State Administration for Industry and Commerce, the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine, the State Environmental Protection Administration will work together in controlling the pollution caused by electronic information products within their respective competence, and establish a harmonized mechanism when necessary. According to the relevant laws, regulations and the Administration, the General Administration of Customs, the State Administration for Industry and Commerce, the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine and other administrative departments of the State Council shall penalize those producers, sellers and importers who would have violated the requirements of the Administration. The Administration will come into effect from 1 July 2006.

The proposed text contains eight chapters, thirty-seven articles, of which the main elements are described below: 1.To change the legal basis for collecting the tobacco surcharge to the Tobacco Hazards Prevention Act, instead of the Tobacco and Alcohol Tax Act, and to establish a mechanism for determining the rate of surcharges to ensure their adequacy; 2.To extend the scope of restrictions on the sale of tobacco products so as to prevent children and youths from getting access to tobacco selling channels; 3.To strengthen the control over tobacco products, brand names and tobacco product containers and to require reporting and publicizing of the contents, additives and emissions of tobacco products; 4.To expand the list of prohibited activities regarding advertising and promotion of tobacco products, to strengthen the control on the sales points of tobacco products and the way of display; 5.To prohibit pregnant women from smoking, impose responsibility of parents and guardians, and prohibit the manufacturing, importation or sale of tobacco products with the appearance of candies or toys; 6.To expand places where smoking is prohibited, stipulate conditions for setting up smoking rooms, and impose duties on owners and workers of the smoking-prohibited places to stop people therein from smoking; 7.To amend types of violations and their respective ranges of administrative fines; and 8.To provide a transitional period for the manufacturing, importation or sale of tobacco products of which the brands exist before the enactment of this proposed amendment and do not comply with the provision of Paragraph 1, Article 6.
