Overview of Revisions to the Quality Labelling Standard for Dressing and Dressing Type Seasoning

Prepared by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries of Japan

I. Objective for revisions

To accommodate the current manufacturing practices of Dressing and Dressing Type Seasoning and to provide consumers with more appropriate information of the products for their choices.

II. Major points of revisions

(Article 2)

The definitions of Mayonnaise and Salad Creamy Dressing will be revised as follows:

- 1. The use of honey is permitted as it is generally considered as an ordinary sweetener; and
- 2. The ratio of edible vegetable fats and oils in total ingredients should be labelled to differentiate qualities of mayonnaise and salad creamy dressing.

The document below is subject to revisions, which is provided by the Law Concerning Standardization and Proper Labelling of Agricultural and Forestry products (Law No.175 of 1950):
