

## **Overview of Revisions to the Quality Labelling Standard for Dressing and Dressing Type Seasoning**

**Prepared by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries of Japan**

### **I. Objective for revisions**

To accommodate the current manufacturing practices of Dressing and Dressing Type Seasoning and to provide consumers with more appropriate information of the products for their choices.

### **II. Major points of revisions**

#### **(Article 2)**

The definitions of Mayonnaise and Salad Creamy Dressing will be revised as follows:

1. The use of honey is permitted as it is generally considered as an ordinary sweetener; and
2. The ratio of edible vegetable fats and oils in total ingredients should be labelled to differentiate qualities of mayonnaise and salad creamy dressing.
