

## **Overview of Revisions to the Quality Labelling Standard for Dehydrated soup**

**Prepared by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries of Japan**

### **I. Objective for revisions**

To provide consumers with more appropriate information of the products of dehydrated soup for their choices.

### **II. Major points of revisions**

#### **( Article 4 )**

1. To require that ingredients should be labelled in the following order: “ingredients other than soup garnish, solid piece and food additives”: “soup garnish and solid piece”: and “food additives”.

#### **( Article 6 )**

2. To add several raw materials to the list of raw materials which are allowed to emphasize their usage in products and establish their minimum content.

### **III . Document subject to revisions**

The document below is subject to revisions, which is provided by the Law Concerning Standardization and Proper Labelling of Agricultural and Forestry products (Law No.175 of 1950):
