### Overview of Revisions to the Quality Labelling Standard For Pressed Ham

### Prepared by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries of Japan

#### I. Objective for revisions

To provide consumers with more appropriate information of pressed ham for their choices.

To be consistent with other Quality Labelling Standards for processed meat products.

# **II. Major points of revisions**

# (Article 3)

- (1) The ingredient label (except for fleshy mass, thickeners and food additives) should be labelled in descending order of percentage weight.
- (2) For the ingredient label of sugars, specific name should be declared such as "isomerized sugar syrup".
