Description of draft amendments to Articles 2 and 13 of Regulations for the Testing of Yields of Nicotine and Tar Contained in Tobacco Products and Labeling of Cigarette Containers

On March 27, 2008 the Regulations for the Testing of Yields of Nicotine and Tar Contained in Tobacco Products and the Labeling of Cigarette Containers (hereafter referred to as the Regulations) were promulgated based on Order #0970700170 with 13 articles. After that, it was amended twice.

In lights of the fact that the pictorial health warnings have been used for four years since June 1, 2014 and their warning effects have worn off, amendments to Articles 2 and 13 are necessary. In addition, the World Health Organization guidelines for pictorial health warning implementation point out that the warnings should be constantly updated and renewed to maintain their effects. Amended regulations take effect as of June 1, 2020.
