

DRAFT REGULATION ON THE AMENDMENT OF TOY SAFETY REGULATION

ARTICLE 1 – The “Decree Law about the Organization and Assignment of Ministry of Customs and Trade numbered 640 and dated 3/6/2011” phrase in the first paragraph of Article 3 of the Toy Safety Regulation published in the Official Gazette dated 4/10/2016 and numbered 29847 has been changed to “Article 441 and 452 of the Presidential Decree on the Presidency No. 1”

ARTICLE 2 - The phrase “Ministry of Customs and Trade” in paragraph (ç) of the first paragraph of Article 4 of the same Regulation has been changed to “Ministry of Trade”.

ARTICLE 3 – The phrase “Minister of Customs and Trade” in the first paragraph of Article 55 of the same Regulation has been changed to “Minister of Trade”.

ARTICLE 4 – In Annex 2 of the same Regulation, the line for the chromium (VI) element in the table in article 12 of the III. Chemical Properties section has been changed as follows.

ARTICLE 7 – 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th lines of the table in Appendix C in Annex 2 of the same Regulation, the phrase “aquatic toy” has been changed as “aqueous toy”.
