#### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Phthalates and Bisphenol-A – Prohibitions – Toys and Child Care Articles

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting the manufacture, sale, or distribution of certain toys or
  child care articles containing bisphenol–A or certain phthalates; requiring a
  person to use the least toxic alternative and prohibiting a person from using
  certain carcinogens or certain reproductive toxicants when complying with a
  certain provision of this Act; providing for a certain penalty; defining certain
  terms; and generally relating to certain toys and child care articles containing
  bisphenol–A or certain phthalates.

(2) "CHILD CARE ARTICLE" MEANS A PRODUCT DESIGNED OR
 INTENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER TO FACILITATE SLEEP, RELAXATION, OR
 THE FEEDING OF A CHILD OR TO HELP A CHILD WITH SUCKING OR TEETHING.



1 "TOY" MEANS A PRODUCT DESIGNED OR INTENDED BY THE (3)  $\mathbf{2}$ MANUFACTURER TO BE USED BY A CHILD WHEN THE CHILD PLAYS. 3 (1) **(B)** ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2010, A PERSON MAY NOT 4 MANUFACTURE, SELL, OR DISTRIBUTE IN COMMERCE ANY TOY OR CHILD CARE 5 **ARTICLE:** 6 **(I)** INTENDED FOR USE BY A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 6  $\mathbf{7}$ YEARS AND CONTAINING BISPHENOL-A: 8 CONTAINING DIETHYLHEXYL PHTHALATE (DEHP), **(II)** 9 DIBUTYL PHTHALATE (DBP), OR BUTYL BENZYL PHTHALATE (BBP) IN 10 CONCENTRATIONS EXCEEDING 0.1%; OR 11 (III) INTENDED FOR USE BY A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 6 12YEARS IF THE TOY OR CHILD CARE ARTICLE: 13 1. ## 1 (C) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS 2 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT 3 EXCEEDING \$10,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2008.
